**What is APID?** The Advanced Placement International Diploma is a separate diploma issued by the College Board that is internationally recognized. To receive the APID a student must earn a grade of 3 or above in five AP exams in specified areas (see below) and request that at least one AP score be sent to an international university.

Five exams are required:

**For whom is APID?** APID is for any student who is zoned for Bartram Trail High School (BTHS) who seeks a rigorous academic program of study that results in an internationally recognized diploma.

**What if I am not zoned for BTHS?** You cannot enroll in APID if you are not zoned for BTHS. You cannot receive a waiver to attend BTHS in order to enroll in APID. It is an academic program, not an academy.

### How will being enrolled in APID impact my course selection?

- Students will remain in cohorts for their English and World Language classes, as possible, in the 9th and 10th grades to allow for better preparation for the AP exams. The course outline can be found on the next page.
- Students will continue their individual learning path in Mathematics, based upon their credits at entrance. It is expected that all 9th-grade students will be enrolled in Algebra 1 Honors or above.
- Students are encouraged to begin an elective area of choice, such as music, art, or theatre, and remain in that area for four years so that they may obtain Honors credits in their elective areas as a juniors and seniors.
- Failure in academic classes will lead to academic probation and removal from the APID program.
