Mission

What is an Academy?

An Academy is a small learning community comprised of a cluster of students who have some of the same teachers for at least three years and who share several classes each year. An Academy combines a college-preparatory curriculum with a

career theme. An Academy promotes partnerships with employers. An advisory group for the Academy includes representatives from the local employer community, Academy

Programs of Study

There are three programs of study within the Academy of Business and Finance. Each program includes four years of coursework.

Finance:

Career Academy students will acquire foundational knowledge and skills for entry-level positions in the field of business and finance. Courses include: Accounting 1 Honors, Accounting 2 Honors, and Personal Finance DE.

Entrepreneurship:

Career Academy students will acquire the fundamental knowledge and skills required to operate a business. Students will progress from the conceptualization of a product to marketing and, eventually, distributing a product and running the school store. Courses include: Principles of Entrepreneurship, Business Management and Law, and Business Ownership DE.
