- ✓ **High School Senior, Junior in your second semester of high school or college student with less than 30 college credit hours.**
- ✓ **Minimum ACT Scores: Math 21 & English 22 AND combined 47**
- ✓ **Minimum SAT Scores: Math 540 & Verbal 550 AND combined 1200**
- ✓ **Ask about Additional options are available if not meeting the combined score**
- ✓ **Not open to Active Duty Service Members**
- ✓ **Not open to Drilling Navy Reservists**
