

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

   community service hours and turning them in
   to the Guidance desk. Hours must be turned in
   before Graduation Day!
- Seniors should try to meet all Bright Futures requirements by the end of the first semester.

- Universities only consider English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and World Language in their GPA calculations
- GPA's are calculated differently between BTHS vs. Universities vs. Bright Futures
- Apply for Bright Futures beginning October 1<sup>st</sup>
- Apply for FAFSA beginning October 1<sup>st</sup>
