 - No charges for digital delivery of transcript
 - Paper copy charge of official transcript is paid to Parchment at a cost of \$2.50 for regular processing
 - Transcript can be sent worldwide
 - Transcripts approvals are made daily
 - Beginning mid-April, Seniors can request final transcripts by choosing the "HOLD FOR GRADES" option
 - Free service to students until July 31st when they become BTHS Alumni

Bright Futures Student Handbook 2016-17

- You must **APPLY** for the scholarship by submitting the Florida Financial Aid Application.
- Bright Futures Scholarships will renew automatically each year if the student **maintains** the required GPA and credit hours.
- If Seniors are planning to apply for Bright Futures they should already be accumulating **community service hours** and turning them in to the Guidance desk. Hours must be turned in before Graduation Day!
- Seniors should try to meet all Bright Futures requirements by the end of the **first** semester.

- 2 years of a world language (in the same language) are required for university admissions & Bright Futures
- Universities only consider English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and World Language in their GPA calculations
- GPA's are calculated differently between BTHS vs. Universities vs. Bright Futures
- Apply for **Bright Futures** beginning **October 1st**
- Apply for **FAFSA** beginning **October 1st**
