



The Florida P.E.O. Scholarship was established in 1994 to provide financial assistance for tuition to qualified women who will be pursuing undergraduate study at a Florida college or university.

ELIGIBILITY

- Florida resident
- Accepted for admission for first year of full-time study at an accredited Florida college or university (private or public).
- Pursuing course of study leading to associate's or bachelor's degree.
- Sponsored by a Florida chapter of the P.E.O. Sisterhood.
- Meets requirements of scholarship, character, and financial need.
- Has high scholastic standing as measured by GPA, class rank, and standardized test scores.
- Students with Florida Pre-Paid College Funds and Take Stock in Children are *not* eligible. Students with Florida Bright Futures *are* eligible.

GRANT AMOUNTS

- Awards up to \$2,500.00. Award amounts based upon number of applicants and funds available each year.
- May be renewed for second year of study pending confirmation of successful completion of first year of full time study (min. 2.5 cumulative GPA and sponsoring chapter recommendation).

APPLICATIONS

- Applicants sponsored by a Florida chapter of the P.E.O. Sisterhood.
- Student applications due to local Florida chapters by **January 15th**, and from local chapter chairmen to state scholarship committee chairman by **February 15th**, prior to student's first year of full time study.
