Community Service Hours

Community service hours are **NOT** required for graduation.

Community service hours **are required** for all Bright Futures Scholarship Awards:

Florida Academic Scholars (100 hrs)

Florida Medallion Scholars (75 hrs), and

Gold Seal Vocational Scholars (30 hrs)

Please note that many other scholarship organizations consider community service when selecting award recipients. Students may begin logging hours the summer before their freshman year.

How to submit Community Service Hours

- 1. The hours must be documented in writing on the letterhead of the non-profit organization.
- 2. Three signatures are required: the student, the student's parent or guardian, and the representative of the organization.
- 3. Letters must be turned in to Mrs. Richards in the main Guidance office.
- 4. It is recommended that students keep a copy of community service letters for their records.
