CSL Venus Manly Scholarship

Venus Manly was an inspiration to many of her fellow students, teachers and the members of the Center for Spiritual Living (CSL) St Augustine. She loved attending school! Her bright smile would light up the classroom revealing her desire to learn no matter the pain or discomfort of sitting in a wheelchair for hours of the day.

Continuing in our third year, CSL will offer the Venus Manly scholarship named for a member of the St. Augustine Center who was disabled with cerebral palsy and transitioned early in her young life.

St. Johns County high school seniors with documented disabilities graduating in May 2020 can respond by reflecting on how they have overcome their specific challenges and state a vision of their future contributions. We will invite graduating seniors to present these ideas during a committee interview to compete to win one of three \$1,000 scholarships. Scholarship winners are eligible for ongoing funds and services through the Caring Community Connection Fund.

This scholarship contest will assess the student's writing and presentation skills. We will allow the use of accommodations while completing the application and essay.

Part 1. An essay due by April 1, 2020.

Answer the following question in 500 words or less (min: 250 words). "How have you overcome your specific challenges and what do you see yourself accomplishing through your education?"

The CSL scholarship committee will score the essay and issue invitations to ten (10) semi-finalists to make an in-person interview.

Part 2. An Interview of semi-finalists will take place before April 30th, 2020.

A combination of the highest scores of the applicant's submissions of Part 1 and 2 will determine the three scholarship recipients. Other participants might receive honorariums.

CSL will award the scholarships before May 15, 2020.
