STEP 1: CREATE COLLEGE BOARD ACCOUNT

- Log into an existing College Board account or create a new one at www.collegeboard.org

STEP 2: COMPLETE THE QUESTIONNAIRE

- Everything with an asterisk (*) is required.
- Create a Username (User name should have 6-15 characters made up of letters and numbers)
- Create a Password (Your password must be 7-15 characters with at least 1 letter and 1 number)



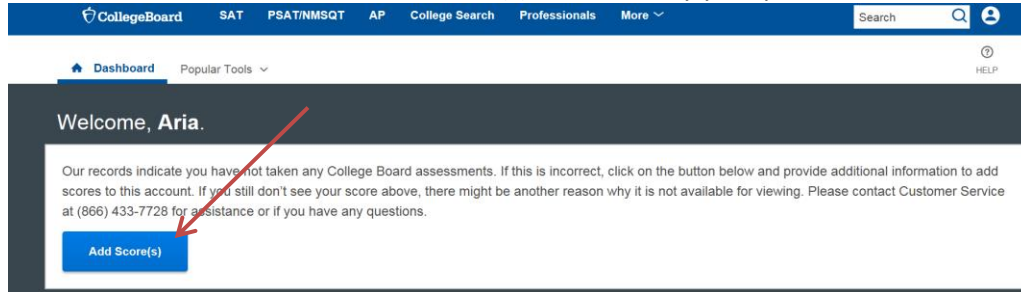

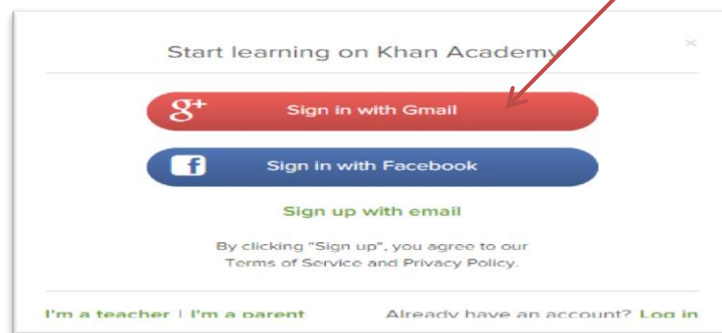

- In a new tab enter www.satpractice.org and click on “Check it out Now”



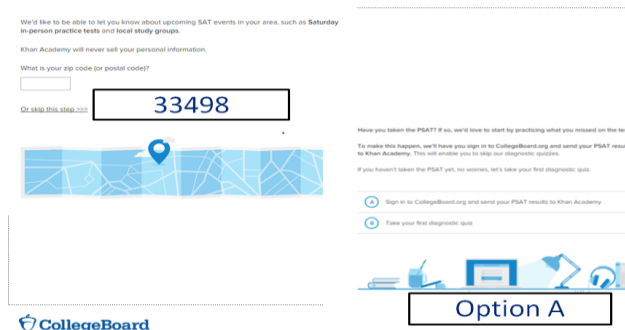
- Sign in with your Gmail email account.


