

Passing the 10th Grade FSA/ELA – Required for Graduation

For 9-11 grade students, the 10th grade FSA/ELA requirement **must still be met at some point before graduation**. This requirement can be fulfilled in multiple ways, so students will have ample opportunity to meet the requirement.

Option 1 to fulfill 10th grade FSA/ELA graduation requirement

Students can earn the Level 3 (350 or above) on the 10th grade FSA ELA. All students who missed this spring administration automatically enter into 'retake' status next year, which means they are eligible to sit for the test each time it is offered (2 times each year: fall and spring). The dates will be listed on the Bartram testing website - <https://www-bths.stjohns.k12.fl.us/testing/>.

Option 2 to fulfill 10th grade FSA/ELA graduation requirement

Students can earn a 480 or above concordant score on the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing portion of the SAT or earn an 18 or above on the average of the English and Reading subtests on the ACT. Students are responsible for signing up and paying for these Saturday test administrations.
