

Passing the Algebra 1 ECO – Required for Graduation

For 9-11 grade students, the Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement **must still be met at some point before graduation**. That requirement can be fulfilled in multiple ways, so students will have ample opportunity to meet the requirement.

Option 1 to fulfill Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement

Students can earn the Level 3 (497 or above) on the Algebra 1 EOC. All students who missed this spring administration automatically enter into 'retake' status next year, which means they are eligible to sit for the test each time it is offered (4 times each year: summer, fall, winter and spring). The dates will be listed on the Bartram testing website - <https://www-bths.stjohns.k12.fl.us/testing/>.

Option 2 to fulfill Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement

Students can earn a concordant score of 430 on the Math section of the PSAT/NMSQT. The PSAT will be administered at Bartram on 10/14/2020. All 10th graders will sit for the test, with scores reported free of charge. All 9th and 11th graders have the option to sit for the test and pay a fee to have scores reported.

Option 3 to fulfill Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement

Students can earn a concordant score on the Math portion of the SAT (420) or the ACT (16). Students are responsible for signing up and paying for these Saturday test administrations.

Option 4 to fulfill Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement (only for certain students)

For students who took Algebra 1 during the 2019-20 school year only, if they earn a Level 3 on the Geometry EOC when they are enrolled in Geometry, that can count as a concordant score.
