Snapshot of Bright Futures

- Bright Futures GPA is **NOT** the same as report card GPA.
- Bright Futures weighs honors, AP, and dual enrollment classes equally with 0.5 per credit earned – NOT 1.0 weight for AP or DE!
- Bright Futures will also accept two additional academic electives toward the GPA calculation if it **benefits** the student.



- You are permitted to use qualifying scores from the June, ACT or SAT to qualify for the Bright Futures test criteria if you did not qualify prior to graduation.
- You must **APPLY** for the scholarship by submitting the Florida Financial Aid Application.
- Bright Futures Scholarships will renew automatically each year if the student maintains the required GPA and credit hours.

How do I see my child's Bright Futures Report?

BTHS School Counselors will provide a paper copy to each student in the spring.

- It is NOT viewable in HAC.
- It CANNOT be emailed.
- These reports are NOT continuously updated.
- Seniors can see their school counselor for a copy NOW.
- Juniors will receive a copy in November and in the spring.

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- *Sophomores* must wait until spring.
- Freshmen do not have Bright Futures reports yet.

- Keep up with course work and establish a good high school GPA.
- Get involved in your school and community.
- Submit service hours to Ms. Richards in the Main Guidance office or at <u>Kathleen.Richards@stjohns.k12.fl.us</u>

- Keep up with course work and maintain a good GPA.
- Seek out community service opportunities.
- Submit service hours to Ms. Richards in the Main Guidance office or at <u>Kathleen.Richards@stjohns.k12.fl.us</u>
- Begin researching colleges.
- Begin planning for next year's courses with college and Bright Futures in mind.

- Keep up with course work and maintain a good GPA.
- Check service hours in HAC. You should have at least 100 hours by now.
- Submit service hours to Ms. Richards in the Main Guidance office or at <u>Kathleen.Richards@stjohns.k12.fl.us</u>
- Schedule meetings with college representatives and ask questions about financial aid and Bright Futures.
- Begin planning for next year's courses with college and Bright Futures in mind.
- Take SAT or ACT and send scores to a Florida school.
