Venus Manly's bright smile and giggles sharing her love for school would light up the classroom. She would ignore the discomfort of sitting in a wheelchair throughout the day because she wanted to learn. This scholarship is for students who have demonstrated Special Courage to graduate from high school and plan to continue school at a Trade School, Community College, or University. The Venus Manly Scholarship is named for a member of the St. Augustine Center and a former St. Johns County student who was disabled with cerebral palsy and transitioned early in her young life.

Continuing in our fourth year, CSL will offer the scholarship to St. Johns County high school seniors with documented disabilities graduating in May/June 2021 can participate. All Scholarship Applicants are eligible for ongoing funds and services through the Caring Community Connection Fund.

This scholarship contest will assess the student's writing and presentation skills. We will allow the use of accommodations while completing the application and essay.

Part 1. An essay due by April 4, 2021.

Answer the following question in 500 words or less (min: 250 words).

"How have you overcome your specific challenges and what do you see yourself accomplishing through your education?"

Part 2. An Interview of up to ten (10) semi-finalists will take place before April 30th, 2021.

A combination of the highest scores of the applicant's submissions of Part 1 and 2 will determine the three scholarship recipients. Other participants might receive honorariums.

CSL will award the scholarships before May 15, 2021.
