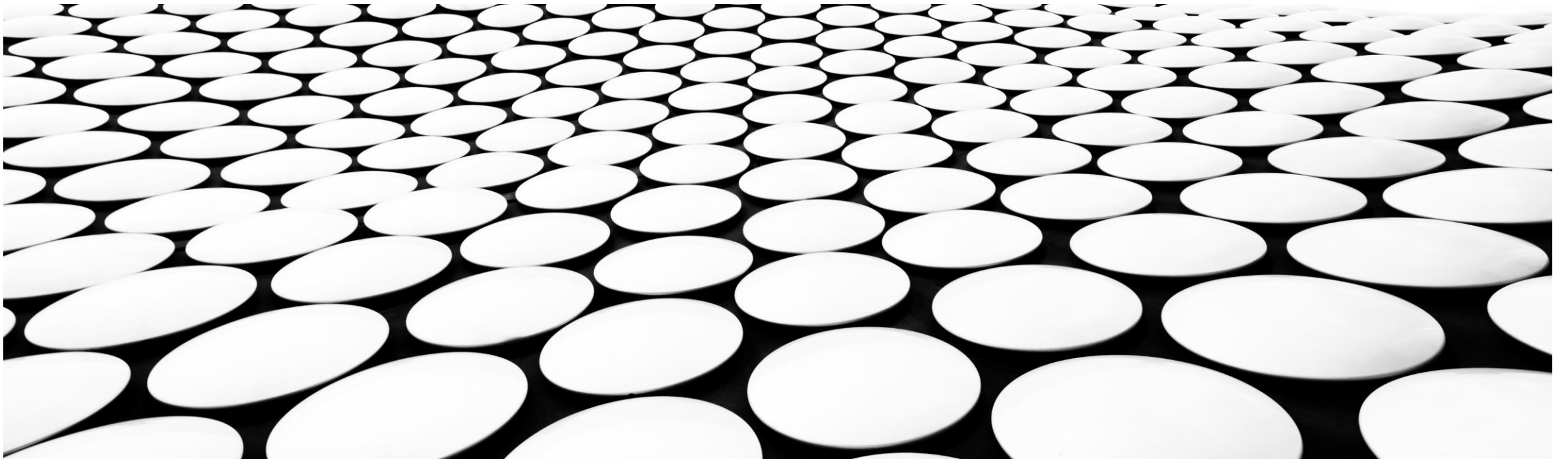

REGISTRATION FOR 22-23 SY RISING 12TH GRADE Q&A

PREPARE FOR APPOINTMENT ...

- Find the appointment time and date using this link - <https://www-bths.stjohns.k12.fl.us/wp-content/uploads/2022/01/Senior-Registration-Appointments-For-Website.pdf>
- Add appointment to their calendar and be on time
- If student is sick on the day of the appointment, stay home – school counselor will schedule a make-up session with them
- If student is going to a 4-year university/college, watch this video from last school year (still great information) - <https://youtu.be/Nf9UKaOcj-A>
- Write down all questions and bring them to the appointment
- Put their requests in HAC ahead of time so we can spend the appointment answering questions and making sure graduation requirements are correct vs data entry

YOUR SENIOR SCHEDULE SHOULD SET YOU UP FOR YOUR FIRST YEAR OUT OF HIGH SCHOOL

- Going to a 4 year college or university? Take classes that will prepare you for your major. Take more classes beyond the minimum required for graduation
- Going to a vocational school? Take classes at FCTC to get a jump start on your education for free.
- Going to SJRSC or FSCJ or another state college? Take SLS over the summer or during fall term to ease you into college mindset.

DO YOU HAVE TO MEET WITH YOUR SCHOOL COUNSELOR?

- All rising seniors will meet individually with their school counselor. A pass with your appointment time will be sent to your English teacher. An email with all appointment times was sent to your parent(s).

HOW WILL STUDENTS CHOOSE ELECTIVES

- In your HAC account. You should have a total of 7 slots filled, including modified/COOP/Intern. Choices must be in HAC by 1/21/22
- Video detailing the process is in the email sent to your parents and posted in Schoology

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DISAGREE WITH THE TEACHER RECOMMENDATION?

- Students should fill out a core re-evaluation form. Link to form is in the email that was sent to parents on 1/7/22 and posted in Schoology.

WHAT IF I WANT AN ELECTIVE COURSE REMOVED FROM MY RECOMMENDATIONS?

- Students should fill out the changing electives form. Link to form is in the email that was sent to parents on 1/7/22 and posted in Schoology.

WHAT IF I'M IN AN ACADEMY AND NO LONGER WANT TO PARTICIPATE?

- Students should fill out the Academy drop form. Forms can be picked up from room N-154 in the NGC
- If you withdraw from an academy and Bartram is NOT your zoned school, you will return to your homezone school.

WHAT IF I'M NOT IN AN ACADEMY AND WANT TO START MY 12TH GRADE YEAR?

- You can't.

CAN I REQUEST A SPECIFIC TEACHER NEXT YEAR?

- No

CAN I REQUEST A SPECIFIC LUNCH NEXT YEAR?

- No

ARE OTHER ELECTIVE CHOICES AVAILABLE TO ME OTHER THAN WHAT IS LISTED IN THE COURSE CATALOG?

- Seniors can take non-graduation requirements via FLVS in addition to classes on their Bartram schedule. They do not need a lab, they can work on these courses at home with a modified schedule.

WHAT IF I WANT TO TAKE A CORE COURSE VIRTUALLY?

- School counselors do not recommend seniors take a graduation requirement via FLVS or SJVS. However, if a student has been successful in a virtual setting, they may take one course online. YOU must request the course via SJVS or FLVS by 6/2/22 with a 8/10/22 start date. Or request it now and finish before senior year!

WHAT IF I WANT TO TAKE MORE THAN ONE COURSE VIRTUALLY?

- Withdraw from Bartram
- Apply and be accepted to either SJVS or FLVS
- Enroll full time in either SJVS or FLVS

WHAT IF I CHANGE MY MIND ABOUT A COURSE AFTER I MEET WITH A COUNSELOR?

- Use the link sent in the email to your parents on 1/7/22 and posted in Schoology.

- No schedule changes or request changes allowed after June 2

DO I HAVE TO TAKE A WORLD LANGUAGE?

- Two years of the same world language is required for:
 - Only if you are college bound (AA to transfer, BS, or BA).
 - Bright Futures Scholarship

HOW CAN I GET A REDUCED SCHEDULE OR DO CO-OP?

- Reduced – Students can reduce up to 4 periods during senior year if the student is **on track for an on time high school graduation**. Students with reduced schedules must provide their own transportation to/from school.
 - This is just a request; it is not a guarantee that you will get your requested modified period(s)
- Co-Op – Students can take up to 3 Co-Op (listed as Executive Internship) courses during 12th grade. You must work 5 hours a week for every co-op course. Students earn credit for Co-Op. There are assignments & timecards that will need to be submitted.

WHAT ABOUT PARKING?

- Parking and scheduling have NOTHING to do with each other.
- If you choose modified, CO-OP, or off campus dual enrollment and DO NOT get a spot, then your parents will have to pick you up/drop you off or you will need to use the form to change your elective choices.

HOW CAN I BE AN INTERN (VPS=VOLUNTARY PUBLIC SERVICE)?

- Request via your HAC account
- Earn 37.5 service hours per semester
- 0.0 credit awarded
- Students will be assigned volunteer location on first day of school.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I STILL NEED TO PASS THE FSA ELA OR CONCORDANT?

- You'll be placed in a reading course (ACT/SAT Test Prep) for the 22-23 SY and you are not on track to graduate with a standard high school diploma. This class isn't optional for students who still need to earn this graduation requirement.
- If you pass the FSA ELA or earn a concordant score via ACT or SAT, the class will be removed.

WHAT IF I EARN A D ON MY TRANSCRIPT?

- If the course is available on SJVS or FLVS, you can take the exact same course again.
- We recommend finishing it before senior year.

WHAT IF I EARN AN F ON MY TRANSCRIPT?

- If the course is available on SJVS or FLVS, you can take the exact same course again or
- You may be placed in an APEX* credit recovery lab(s) next school year (depending on the course you earned an F in).
- *Courses taken in an APEX credit recovery lab will not count towards NCAA eligibility.

CAN I TAKE DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES AT SJRSC NEXT YEAR?

- Yes, if you meet the qualifications (3.0 GPA and test scores).
- Deadlines for SJRSC campus dual enrollment is different from Bartram deadlines. Pay attention to remind text messages and schoology messages for dates/deadlines.
- Scheduling dual enrollment must work with Bartram's schedule.

HOW MANY SJRSC DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES CAN I TAKE?

- If you are taking ALL your graduation requirements via SJRSC – maximum of 16 credit hours per fall/spring term. If you do this, you cannot take any classes on Bartram’s campus.
- If you are taking some classes on Bartram’s campus, you can take up to 10 credit hours per fall/spring term.

CAN I TAKE DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES ON BARTRAM'S CAMPUS NEXT YEAR?

- No, dual enrollment on Bartram's campus will not be offered next school year.

CAN I TAKE DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES AT FCTC NEXT YEAR?

- Yes, if you meet the qualifications (2.0 GPA) and have room in your schedule.
- Deadlines for FCTC campus dual enrollment is different from Bartram deadlines. Pay attention to remind text messages and schoology messages for dates/deadlines.

- If you are going to apply to a competitive University, yes. If you are going into a science related major, yes. Choose a course that sounds interesting to you and will prepare you for your post-secondary plans.

I'M DONE WITH MY MATH CREDITS FOR GRADUATION. SHOULD I TAKE AN ADDITIONAL MATH NEXT YEAR?

- If you are going to attend college, yes. Choose a course that sounds interesting to you and will prepare you for your post-secondary plans.

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

- Do not sacrifice your mental health to take on more than you can handle!
- If you want to go to college, you will. Don't worry.
- Consider all your life commitments – work, extracurricular, etc.

- Log into HAC then click Classes Icon
- Look at the “Schedule” tab, count course requests. All students need to have 7 classes (modified, CO OP, and intern counts as a ‘class’).
- Go to the “Requests” tab, choose enough electives to make it 7 classes (if you have less under the schedule tab).
- Look at the “Schedule” tab - Do you have all of your graduation requirements?
- If no, click link and fill out the “Course Recommendation Re-evaluation Form” - <https://www-bths.stjohns.k12.fl.us/courseregistration/>
- If you do have your graduation requirements- good.
- Look at your 7 classes. Are there any NON-ACADEMY electives you want to change? If so, fill out the “Non-Academy Elective Replacement Form” located here: <https://www-bths.stjohns.k12.fl.us/courseregistration/>
