GENERAL MASTER SCHEDULE PROCESS

Teachers have already made core course and upperlevel elective recommendations

Students choose the rest of their 7 courses in HAC – DEADLINE is January 28th

Students have until last day of school to use online forms to make changes to requests

March – July BT is creating the master schedule based on your choices

The week of July 18th there will be a Schedule Preview in HAC, so you can see your schedule before school starts.

• Remember we won't do schedule changes at this time, only corrections

RECOMMENDATIONS VS REQUESTS

Current teachers make recommendations for next year's core courses and upperlevel electives.

Requests are what a student gets to pick in HAC to complete their list of 7 total courses for next year.


REQUESTING CHANGES VS SCHEDULE CHANGES

We don't do schedule changes, so students need to make sure their recommendations and requests are correct!

When requesting changes, students should use the forms on the Registration Webpage to request:

- Core re-evaluations deadline June 2nd
- Non-Academy Elective Replacement (change elective) - deadline January 28th – June 2nd
- Academy drop deadline February 10th
- Virtual courses (deadline to replace a BTHS course with the virtual version is July 15th)



Bartram Trail Rising 12th Graders

Links will not be live until January 13. Students will then be able to login to their HAC to choose their schedule for the 2022-2023 school year.

For the 2022-2023 school year, <u>Bartram Trail High School will be conducting their</u> registration completely ONLINE.

YOU are the only group of students that will have official meeting times with your counselor.

You will receive a pass with the date/time of your appointment in your English class. You can also click below for a list of appointment times/dates by student ID number.

(If you do not have an English on campus, Ms. Richards in the main guidance area has your pass)

* Students are welcome to call their parents during this appointment with their school counselor; parents cannot attend in person.

If you cannot make your time/date, a make-up date will be scheduled for you. Do not come to the appointment if you are sick or not feeling well.

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 \sim Please have your student add their appointment to their calendar and be on time.

~ Students should write down all questions and bring them to the appointment. Your student can call you during their 10-minute appointment.

~ Students should put their requests in HAC ahead of time so we can spend the appointment answering questions and making sure graduation requirements are correct vs data entry.

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~If your student is sick on the day of the appointment, please have them stay home – their school counselor will schedule a make-up session.

~If your student plans to attend a 4year university/college, please have them watch this video from last school year (still great information) -<u>https://youtu.be/Nf9UKaOcJ-A</u>

A SENIOR **SCHEDULE** SHOULD SET UP THE STUDENT FOR THEIR FIRST YEAR OUT OF HIGH SCHOOL

Going	to a 4 year college or university? Take classes that will prepare you for your major. Take more classes beyond the minimum required for graduation	
Going	to a vocational school? Take classes at FCTC to get a jump start on your education for free.	
Going	to a state college like SJRSC or FSCJ? Take SLS over the summer or during fall term to ease into the college mindset.	

WHAT HAPPENS IF A STUDENT DISAGREES WITH THE TEACHER RECOMMENDATION?

Students should fill out a Core Reevaluation form (English, Math, Science, Social Studies). The link to this form is in the email that was sent to parents on Jan 7th and posted in Schoology.

ARE OTHER ELECTIVE CHOICES AVAILABLE OTHER THAN WHAT IS LISTED IN THE COURSE CATALOG?

Seniors can take non-graduation requirements via FLVS in addition to classes on their Bartram schedule.

Senior students do not need a lab as they can work on their online courses at home with a modified schedule.

WHAT IF A STUDENT WANTS TO TAKE A CORE COURSE VIRTUALLY?

School counselors do not recommend seniors take a graduation requirement via FLVS or SJVS. However, if a student has been successful in a virtual setting, they may take one course online.

They must request the course via SJVS or FLVS by June 2^{nd} with an 8/10/22 start date. Or they can request it now and finish before senior year!

WHAT IF A STUDENT WANTS TO TAKE MORE THAN ONE COURSE VIRTUALLY?

Students wanting to take multiple online courses would need to withdraw from Bartram.

They would either apply for Home Education

or

apply and be accepted as a full-time St. Johns Virtual School or Florida Virtual School student. There are specific deadlines for this.

WHAT IF A STUDENT CHANGES THEIR MIND ABOUT A **COURSE AFTER** MEETING WITH **A COUNSELOR?**

No schedule changes or request for changes are allowed after June 2nd.

DO STUDENTS HAVE TO TAKE A WORLD LANGUAGE?

Two years of the same world language is required for:

- Only if you are college bound (AA to transfer, BS, or BA).
- Bright Futures Scholarship

HOW CAN A SENIOR GET A MODIFIED SCHEDULE OR DO CO-OP? Students can modify up to 4 periods during senior year if the student is on track for high school graduation. Students with modified schedules must provide their own transportation to/from school.

This is just a request; it is not guaranteed they will get their requested modified period(s).

CO-OP ~ Students can take up to 3 CO-OP (listed as Executive Internship) courses during 12th grade. You must work 5 hours a week for every co-op course. Students earn credit for CO-OP. There are assignments & timecards that will need to be submitted. HOW CAN A SENIOR BE AN INTERN (VPS=VOLUNTARY PUBLIC SERVICE)? ~ Request via the student's HAC account.

~ Earn 37.5 service hours per semester (75 hours for the year)

 \sim 0.0 credit awarded

~ Students will be assigned volunteer location on first day of school.

WHAT HAPPENS IF A SENIOR STILL NEEDS TO PASS THE FSA ELA OR **CONCORDANT?**

~ These students are not on track to graduate with a standard high school diploma.

~ Students will be placed in a reading course (ACT/SAT Test Prep) for the 22-23 school year. This class is not optional for students who still need to earn this graduation requirement.

 \sim If a student passes the FSA ELA or earns a concordant score via ACT or SAT, the class will be removed.

HOW CAN STUDENTS EARN GRADE FORGIVENESS?



Students can retake classes in which they earn a D or F (if the class is offered on FLVS, SJVS, or APEX Credit Recovery)



All grades appear on the official transcript. Forgiven grades will still show on transcript but will not be included in GPA calculation



All grade forgiveness should be completed before senior year



Options for grade recovery: St Johns Virtual School, Florida Virtual School, and/or APEX credit recovery*



*Courses taken via APEX credit recovery will not count towards NCAA eligibility

ARE COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS NEEDED FOR GRADUATION?

Not needed for graduation

Needed for \$\$ (scholarships, including Bright Futures)

Documented by a verification letter that is on letterhead

Community service verification letters and volunteer service plan form can be turned into Ms. Richards in the school counseling area of the main building

CAN A SENIOR TAKE DUAL ENROLLMENT **COURSES AT SJRSC** NEXT YEAR?

Yes, if they meet the qualifications (3.0 GPA and test scores).

Students are registering for their BTHS courses, not for dual enrollment. Deadlines for SJRSC campus dual enrollment are different from Bartram deadlines. Pay attention to remind text messages and schoology messages for dates/deadlines.

Dual enrollment courses must work with the student's BTHS schedule. One hour of drive time is required (to or from) for courses taken on the SJRSC campus.

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

Do parents have access to student's dual enrollment course grades? Can they correspond with students' college professors?

 No. Students are expected to handle all communication because they are considered a college student. No one at SJRSC, including students' professors, can communicate with parents per FERPA.

What if students have accommodations?

 The student will need to work with the SJRSC Disabilities Services office to determine what accommodations, if any, can be used in college classes

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

Are dual enrollment courses 'watered down' to fit the needs of high school students?

 No. These courses are adult level courses and students should have not only the academic maturity, but the social/emotional maturity to handle adult content matter and academic responsibilities.

What is the impact of dual enrollment?

 Dual enrollment is the start of a college transcript. Dual enrollment grades will follow students forever, which can impact admittance to college/university, acceptance into the students major, and enrollment in graduate school.
Doing poorly in dual enrollment courses may also negatively impact financial aid.

HOW MANY SJRSC DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES CAN A STUDENT TAKE?

Students taking ALL of their graduation requirements via SJRSC can take a maximum of 16 credit hours per fall/spring term. These students cannot take any classes on Bartram's campus.

Students taking some classes on SJRSC's campus or online can take up to 10 credit hours per fall/spring term.

CAN A STUDENT TAKE DUAL ENROLLMENT **COURSES ON BARTRAM'S CAMPUS NEXT** YEAR?

No, dual enrollment on Bartram's campus will not be offered next school year.

CAN A STUDENT TAKE DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES AT FCTC NEXT YEAR? Yes, students need to meet the qualifications (2.0 GPA) and have room in their schedule.

Deadlines for FCTC campus dual enrollment is different from Bartram deadlines. Pay attention to remind text messages and schoology messages for dates/deadlines.
