## PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS

#### 9th to 10th Grade

• 5 credits

#### 10th to 11th Grade

• II credits

#### 11th to 12th Grade

• 17 credits

#### 12th Grade to Graduation

• 24 or more

- GPA's update after every semester:
  - In January, after semester I grades post
  - In the summer, after semester 2 grades post
  - EOC courses: Algebra, Geometry, Biology and US History: State EOC course (30% averaged when state releases scores). Final grade is determined.
- AP, Dual Enrollment, and honors counts towards your weighted GPA
- Only unweighted GPA counts towards graduation and qualifications for Dual Enrollment



### GRADE FORGIVENESS

Students can retake classes in which they earn a D or F (if the class is offered on FLVS, SJVS, or APEX Credit Recovery)

All grades appear on the official transcript. Forgiven grades will still show on transcript but will not be included in GPA calculation

All grade forgiveness should be completed before senior year

Options for grade recovery: St Johns Virtual School, Florida Virtual School, and/or APEX credit recovery\*

\*Courses taken via APEX credit recovery will not count towards NCAA eligibility

If grade forgiveness is necessary, students should request an APEX or Virtual Lab on their schedule for next school year during their meeting with the counselor

- Schools are required by the State to place students in intensive reading if they score a level 1 or 2 on the FAST ELA Reading
  - Administration will review FAST scores during the summer and students will be placed in an intensive reading course. In 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade intensive readings focuses on ACT/SAT prep.

# STUDENT APPOINTMENTS VIA ENGLISH CLASSES

- All rising 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students have been scheduled for a 10-minute appointment to sit down with their school counselor to go over course requests.
- If parents are interested in being part of their student's appointment students are welcome to call their parent during the conference. Parents cannot attend in person.
- The schedule of appointments was emailed home.
- If a student is absent for their appointment, a pass will be sent to you with your make up meeting date and time.
- If you do not have an English class on campus a pass will be sent to you with your scheduled meeting date and time.

Grades – A grade of "C" or better in the previous honors course. Students earning an "A" in a pervious standard class, may be recommended for Honors or AP

FSA/EOC – Level 4 or 5 in appropriate area and not less than a level 3 in any area
