



- GPA's update after every semester:
 - In January, after semester I grades post
 - In the summer, after semester 2 grades post
 - EOC courses: Algebra, Geometry, Biology and US History: State EOC course (30% averaged when state releases scores). Final grade is determined.
- AP, Dual Enrollment, and honors counts towards your weighted GPA
- Only unweighted GPA counts towards graduation and qualifications for Dual Enrollment

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT GPA:

GRADE FORGIVENESS

Students can retake classes in which they earn a D or F (if the class is offered on FLVS, SJVS, or EDMENTUM Credit Recovery)

All grades appear on the official transcript. Forgiven grades will still show on transcript but will not be included in GPA calculation

All grade forgiveness should be completed before senior year

Options for grade recovery: St Johns Virtual School, Florida Virtual School, and/or Edmentum credit recovery^{*}

*Courses taken via Edmentum credit recovery will not count towards NCAA eligibility. Student Athletes should not use this platform for grade recovery.

If grade forgiveness is necessary, students should request an EDMENTUM or Virtual Lab on their schedule for next school year during their meeting with the counselor

- Schools are required by the State to place students in intensive reading if they score a level 1 or 2 on the FAST ELA Reading
 - Administration will review FAST scores during the summer and students will be placed in an intensive reading course. In 11th and 12th grade intensive readings focuses on ACT/SAT test taking tips and preparation.
 - Intensive Reading is an elective course so this will replace an elective that the student has chosen.

INTENSIVE READING

Grades – A grade of "C" or better in the previous honors course. Students earning an "A" in a pervious standard class, may be recommended for Honors or AP

FAST/EOC – Level 4 or 5 in appropriate area and not less than a level 3 in any area

The last day to make schedule changes is the last day of the school year 5-24-24 at 4:00 p.m.

To request a virtual class next year the student must request the course on FLVS/SJVS with a start date by 5-24-24 or 8-12-24 start date. Counselor approval is needed.
