

Graduation requirements for a Standard 24 Credit Diploma

- Assessments (Algebra 1 EOC and Grade 10 ELA FAST Test)
- 2.0 Cumulative, Unweighted GPA
- 24 specific credits



Assessments

Students must pass two state assessments to graduate – The Grade 10 FAST ELA and the B.E.S.T. Algebra 1 EOC. Students may earn a concordant score for each test in lieu of passing the FAST and/or the B.E.S.T.

Level 3 - OR one of the following **Concordant Options**:

- * 480 on SAT EBRW
- * 470 on the PSAT R&W
- * Average of 18 on ACT Eng & Read
- * 36 on CLT Sum of Verbal Reason & Gramr/Writing sections

B.E.S.T. (Algebra 1 EOC)

Level 3 - OR one of the following **Concordant Options**:

- * 430 on PSAT/NMSQT Math
- * 420 on SAT Math
- * 16 on ACT Math
- * Level 3 (499) on Geometry EOC
- * 11 on CLT Quantitative Reasoning

9-11th Grades (Effective 8-19-25)

Grade 10 FAST (Reading)

Level 3 - OR one of the following **Concordant Options**:

- * 490 on SAT EBRW
- * 470 on the PSAT R&W
- * Average of 18 on ACT Eng & Read
- * 39 on CLT Sum of Verbal Reasoning & Gramr/Writing sections

B.E.S.T. (Algebra 1 EOC)

Level 3 - OR one of the following **Concordant Options**:

- * 430 on PSAT/NMSQT Math
- * 420 on SAT Math
- * 16 on ACT Math
- * Level 3 (499) on Geometry EOC
- * 14 on CLT Quantitative Reasoning

Credits



24 credits must be earned in all of the following:

- English 1, 2, 3, and 4
- Algebra, Geometry, and two additional Math courses
- Biology and two additional Sciences
- World History, US History, Government, and Economics
- 1 Fine/Performing/Practical art or CTE
- HOPE
- 8 elective credits (to include .5 credit of Personal Finance and Money Management)
 - If you're planning to attend college, you will need two credits in the SAME world language

Grade Point Average - GPA

GPA - 2.0 cumulative unweighted or higher

- ∘ 2.0 is a "C" average
- Check HAC regularly to keep track of grades



Grade Recovery

Students who have earned a grade of D or F in a course can retake the course for grade recovery online or through Edmentum. Once the new higher grade is earned the Registrar's office will zero out the F or D previous grade and replace it with the higher grade. Please note that the original grade of D or F will remain on the transcript but will not affect the GPA.

NCAA guidelines – collegiate athletes cannot take grade recovery through Edmentum but must complete grade recovery on FLVS or SJVS.

- The state allows for grade averaging one failed semester with a passing semester to pass a course and earn credit, if possible. We still recommend re-taking the half credit failed course for grade recovery.
- The FLVS website for online grade recovery is www.flvs.net Students may also choose St. Johns Virtual (SJVS) at www.stjohnsvirtual.com, which is the district online option. Counselor approval is needed to take any course for grade recovery.
- During registration, grade recovery labs can be added on a student's BTHS schedule to complete during the school year. Prior to summer break Counselors will recommend grade recovery courses through Edmentum that can be completed at home over the summer months.


What you need to know about GPA:

- In January, after semester 1 grades post
- In the summer, after semester 2 grades post

AP, Dual Enrollment, and honors counts towards your weighted GPA

Only a student's unweighted GPA counts towards graduation
