# Xello FOR SENIORS

St. Johns County School District has partnered with Xello for students to track college applications, request letters of recommendations, request transcripts for college applications and so much more.

Xello works in conjunction with Common App.

Before students begin working in Xello, they should complete the following tasks:

- 1. Create a Common App account
- 2. Link their current high school
- 3.Add a school to the My Colleges list
- 4. Fill out the preferred start term
- 5. Sign FERPA Authorization Release
