



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT GPA:

- GPA's update after every semester:
 - In January, after semester 1 grades post
 - In the summer, after semester 2 grades post
 - EOC courses: Algebra, Geometry, Biology and US History: State EOC course. Q1, Q2, Q3 & Q4 grades count as 70% of the grade. The EOC score counts as 30% of the grade and averaged when state releases scores. Final grade is determined.
- AP, Dual Enrollment, and honors counts towards your weighted GPA
- Only unweighted GPA counts towards graduation and qualifications for Dual Enrollment
- All high school courses count in your high school GPA

HOPE WAIVERS

- Towards the end of sophomore year School Counselors will provide ROTC waiver forms to all ROTC students to complete. These forms must be signed and returned to Guidance before the end of the school year. The HOPE waiver will be coded by the Registrar's Office for all students who have successfully completed two years of ROTC with passing grades.
- For student athletes who have completed two full years in a Varsity Sport these students will also be processed for HOPE waivers after they have completed their forms with signatures to be validated by the BTHS Athletics office. The Athletic Director will sign off on these athletic waivers.
- For students who have completed two full years of Marching Band with passing grades, this will satisfy the requirements for HOPE and students can obtain a HOPE waiver.

TRANSCRIPTS AND TIPS

If you need a transcript you need to log on to our BTHS website and order through parchment. The link is www.parchment.com/u/registration/9276/institution

It is a great idea now to order a transcript and keep for your records to review and keep track of all of your grades and credits earned.

Xello is a college and career readiness program. Each student has an account, and it is accessed via CLEVER on the BTHS student links. Students and parents received Xello information. Students completed their career interest inventories via Social Studies classes and elective courses such as World Cultural Geography and AP Human Geography.

Volunteer Hours: Please do not wait until the last minute to complete and submit your service hours. The community service reflection log forms are located in Guidance so pick up a form this week and start coordinating and arranging to complete your hours with a nonprofit agency. Students can also use their work hours to count for community service. Copies of paystubs are needed along with the reflection log. The goal is to be completed by the end of junior year.

CAREER FAIR 2025-2026

In the month of April Counselors will plan to host a career fair for our students that will showcase a variety of careers. We will be utilizing members from our community to participate and share their important careers with our students. Students will also be able to take a career interest inventory via Xello lessons.

IMPORTANT DATES AND DEADLINES

- 1-16-25 to 1-21-26 elective options open on HAC for students to pick their elective choices for next school year. HAC closes at 4:00 p.m. on 1-21-26 to choose electives. School Counselors can still add elective choices at the registration appointment.
- 2-20-26 Academy drop forms are due by 5:00 p.m. If students drop ROTC after 1 year they must sign up for HOPE as they no longer will qualify for the HOPE waiver.
- 5-29-26 is the deadline to request changes to your schedule for next year by 4:00 p.m. Complete and submit forms online only.
- To request a virtual class next year the student must request the course online on www.flvs.net with a start date on or before 5-29-26 or 8-10-26. Counselor approval is needed. If a student needs to request a virtual lab class to complete the course the online form request must be received by 5-29-26. Students must either complete the core recommendation re-evaluation form to request dropping a core course and adding the lab class or the non academy elective form to drop an elective and replace with a virtual lab class.

YOUR TO DO LIST

CHECK HAC

- Make your elective selections prior to your registration appointment. Elective options open and closes in HAC on this date range 1-16-26 to 1-21-26 by 4:00 p.m.
- Stop by to see your School Counselor during the 4th period lunch open hours with any questions and/or concerns
- Write down any questions you may have with regards to the registration appointment
- Attend your registration appointment with your English class. If you are absent a make up date and time will be scheduled for you. The registration schedule is posted on our BTHS website. We will meet in the auditorium lobby for registration. Students can call parents on their phone to be a part of the registration process. There are no parent in-person appointments at BTHS.

DATES

- Pay attention to dates and deadlines. The last day to make changes to your schedule is 5-29-26 via online form only by 4:00 p.m.
- Return any core recommendation re-evaluation forms and/or non academy elective forms before 4-15-26. Submit online by 4:00 p.m.
- Sign up for any FLVS/SJVS courses online with start date at the end of this school year on 5-29-26 or the beginning of next school year 8-10-26. Counselor approval is needed. Deadline to request a virtual lab class is by 5-29-26 at 4:00 p.m.
- Remember there are **NO SCHEDULE CHANGES** in August 2026 once the school year starts. You will preview your schedule in the summer months on 7-22-26 and 7-23-26.
- Please note, the Registrar's office is creating a master schedule for all students and staff who may teach multiple courses in subject area. Class sizes and lunch capacities need to be balanced as well. We cannot guarantee lunch with friends or class sections with friends.
