Acknowledgement of Participation Requirements Form

We have read and understand the bylaws for the BTHS Chapter of the National Honor Society. The following are the student's obligations as a member:

- Attendance at meetings is mandatory. Meetings are held once a month for approximately 30 minutes. The day and time of the meeting is decided by the NHS Executive Committee prior to the start of each school year (First Friday of each month at BTHS). I understand that if I miss more than two monthly meetings I will be dismissed from the club.
- NHS meetings start on time, no one will be admitted after the published start time.
- I understand that I am expected to earn at least 25 community service hours each academic year and that 5 of the hours should be from NHS sanctioned projects.
- I understand that membership is based upon selection by an anonymous Faculty Council and that the proceedings of this council and all materials presented to it will be held in confidence by the school administration.
- Maintaining a high level of conduct is expected as a member of NHS. Failure to do so (level 3 offense or higher) will result in dismissal from the club.
- Member dues are collected in the fall. (\$35 includes t-shirt for new members and \$25 for returning members)
- I understand that failure to attend meetings, maintain my academic or disciplinary standing, or failure to participate in service activities will be grounds for dismissal.
