

Academic Cords/Stoles

The following criteria is based on weighted GPA calculation from the end of the seventh semester with no rounding up.

Summa Cum Laude: Seniors with a weighted GPA of 4.5000 or above: Gold Cord

Magna Cum Laude: Seniors with a weighted GPA of 4.0000 to 4.4999: Silver Cord

Cum Laude: Seniors with a weighted GPA of 3.5000 to 3.9999: Black Cord

National Honor Society Stoles

NHS members who meet the qualifications and opt to pay for a stole may wear it to the graduation ceremony: White NHS Stole

Saint Johns River State College Stoles

Graduates earning the AA Degree may order the stole from SJRSC. It may be worn to their high school graduation: White SJRSC Stole
