
Parking Spot Painting Information Sheet

- When: Friday, September 19th (Teacher Inservice Day). We will begin at 8:00 a.m. <u>Be on time</u>. We have found it takes 4 hours paint most spots. All painting and clean-up must be <u>completed by 12:00 p.m</u>. Painters arriving late, may not be permitted to begin.
- Cost: \$50 (This covers the cost for the cover-up event in the Spring.)
- Parking spot painting design forms and permission slips must be turned into Ms.
 Hastings at BTHS by <u>September 10th</u>. Please bring printed copies in or email
 Shawna.Hastings@stjohns.k12.fl.us.
- Please remember you must bring your own supplies. Including, but not limited to
 paint, rollers, roller stick, paint brushes, pans, containers for small amounts of paint
 (plastic take-out containers work great!), a broom to clear the spot, shade tents, trash
 bags. Please bring plenty of water as it may be hot outside. NOTE: ONLY WATER-BASED
 LATEX PAINTS MAY BE USED.
- Bring chalk and a ruler to create the 4-inch border around the perimeter of the spot.
- The cover-up day will occur in April. Date TBD.
- Participants agree to participate in the cover-up event or be subject to a \$60 fine, charged to Senior Debt Day fines.
- In the event of inclement weather, our Senior Sponsors will make a judgement call by 6:30 a.m. the morning of the event. The Senior Officers will post on the Senior Class Officer Instagram page @btco26 if we need to postpone. The rain date is Saturday, September 20th.
- I agree to follow all guidelines above and understand the consequences if I fail to do so.
