## **PSAT Parent Communication – 2025**

Bartram Trail High School is pleased to offer 9th, 10th, and 11th-grade students the opportunity to take the PSAT/NMSQT® (Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) in October 2025 (exact date to be determined).

The PSAT/NMSQT is an essential step in college preparation. It offers students the opportunity to experience a college readiness exam and helps identify those who may benefit from advanced coursework. The PSAT mirrors the <u>SAT</u> in structure, timing, and content, providing excellent practice while evaluating essential skills in Reading, Writing, and Math—key areas for success in college and beyond. For **Juniors**, the PSAT/NMSQT also serves as the **qualifying exam for the National Merit Scholarship Program**.

**Sophomores (10<sup>th</sup> graders)** will receive the PSAT at **no cost**, as it is fully funded by the state. **10<sup>th</sup> graders DO NOT have to register nor pay for the exam.** 

Freshmen (9<sup>th</sup>) and Juniors (11<sup>th</sup>) must register and pay a \$22 testing fee. Registration must be completed online using the SchoolPay links provided below, by 11:59 p.m., September 14, 2025. This deadline is firm due to College Board's enforced policies for payment and registration in computer-based testing. No exception, so please plan accordingly. Space based on availability.

Students with IEP, 504, or ELL plans may qualify for accommodations. Please understand accommodations used in school are not automatically granted on College Board exams. Accommodations must be submitted and approved by College Board, in order to be used on any College Board exam. The deadline to request accommodations for the PSAT/NMSQT is August 22, 2025.
