






ACT SCHOOL DAY

FEBRUARY 25, 2026



All 11th grade students are automatically registered for ACT School Day. Students do not need to pay a test fee, nor do they need to register in advance. Students in 9th, 10th, and 12th grades are not permitted to test. February 25, will also be a Virtual School Day for all students not testing.



DEADLINE TO APPLY FOR ACCOMMODATIONS IS JANUARY 5, 2026

AP-ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMS

All students enrolled in an AP course on campus or through FLVS will take an AP Exam in May. Students who meet this criteria do not pay an exam fee.


All students in AP courses are required to join AP Classroom for their respective courses. Joining AP Classroom registers students for the AP exam and orders their test materials.

BTHS assumes the cost of AP exams, which is \$99 per exam. Students who drop one or more AP courses after the AP Registration and Ordering deadline WILL incur a \$40 fee per course dropped. Students who need to late test or are absent on the day of testing are also subject to fees of \$40 or more. This fee is determined by College Board.

Students who <u>currently</u> have an IEP or 504 plan may be eligible for accommodations. The deadline to apply for accommodations on AP exams is January 16, 2026. If your student has not already applied and meets the above criteria, please submit your request <u>HERE</u>.



Non-College Reportables, also known as NCRs, are SAT or ACT exam scores that are NOT reported to colleges or scholarship agencies. NCR scores are used for state assessment purposes only.



NCRs are offered in the fall and spring semesters. These exams are for students who have not passed the F.A.S.T. Grade 10 or B.E.S.T. Algebra 1, which are needed for graduation..



Fall NCRs test dates are reserved for 12th graders only. 11th graders are currently able to take the spring ACT NCR



All students who take the NCR receive 1.5x extended time



11th or 12th graders who wish to take an NCR must pay a test fee. Students interested in NCRs should speak with their Counselor.



This year, Bartram Trail offers AICE English General Paper, which is one of our 12th grade English courses. Information about the testing schedule will be shared at a later date.

NATIONAL SAT & ACTA TESTING




