ABOUT THE TEST:

On **Tuesday, February 24, 2026**, all 11th-grade students will have the opportunity to take a college-reportable ACT. The school district automatically registers all 11th grade students for the ACT. Students who take the ACT will be able to share their ACT scores with colleges and universities. Students can access ACT preparation resources by visiting [ACT Test Prep](#). Please note, there is not a make-up date for this test.

TEST DAY INFORMATION

WHAT TO BRING ON TEST DAY:

- **Must bring an ID** (School, Driver's License, Permit- **no digital ID**) pencils, calculator, water, and a snack.
- Calculators will not be provided; however, all questions can be answered without a calculator, if forgotten. Please visit [ACT Calculator Policy](#) to view the calculator policy.
- **Please ensure your student knows his/her full home mailing address**

TEST FORMAT:

- The ACT will be a paper/pencil test
- The Science and Writing sections will **NOT** be given
- Standard test time for the ACT will be 2 hours and 5 minutes, excluding breaks and test day tasks
- **Students with extended times will test longer and some over multiple days**

PRE-TEST INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS:

All students must complete Non-Test Information to receive and send their ACT scores. **Students enrolled in an 11th grade English class at BTHS will complete this task in school.** Students without an English class will receive instructions on completing this task in early February and will have an opportunity to receive guided help before or after school on 2/18 in the Media Center .

TESTING LOCATIONS:

Students will test in assigned testing rooms organized by last names. Testing room rosters will be sent out and posted around campus as we get closer to test day.

Students whose forms are submitted on time will be released at the conclusion of testing and will not need to sign-out. If the form is **not** completed by **Thursday, February 19**, any request for early dismissal will need to be completed using the regular early dismissal form. Students who do not have approval to leave early will be required to remain on campus. **Early dismissal requests by phone or email will not be accepted.** Please, if you know your student will want to leave campus after testing is complete, PLEASE submit this form by the deadline.
