If you have received this email, then your son/daughter participated in at least one College Board Advanced Placement (AP) Exam during the 2018-2019 school year. **Scores will become available through your son/daughter's College Board account this upcoming Friday, July 5 at 8:00am.** This email is to serve as a helpful tool to better understand your son/daughter's AP scores.

HOW TO ACCESS:

- Click the following link and follow the prompts to view your son/daughter's scores: www.apscore.org.
 - The following information is required to access scores:
 - Your son/daughter's College Board account username and password
 - If you have not already, go to www.collegeboard.org/register to create a College Board account and be sure to use the same information on the account as was provided on the answer sheet.
 - Your son/daughter's AP number (or school based student ID if they provided it on their AP answer sheet).
 - *Please note that the link above will not work until Friday, July 5 at 8:00am

HOW MUCH COLLEGE CREDIT DID MY SON/DAUGHTER EARN BY PASSING THEIR AP EXAM(S)?

- Colleges/Universities accept credit for passing AP exams differently.
