**WHEN:** Monday, November 25

**WHAT:** Healthy Relationships/Dating Violence Assembly

- The Betty Griffin Center will be hosting assemblies in the auditorium regarding Healthy Relationships and Dating Violence. Florida Statutes [1003.42](#) & [1006.148](#) and [School Board policy 5.26](#) state that “health curriculum for students in grades 7 through 12 shall include dating violence and abuse. The dating violence and abuse component shall include, but is not limited to the definition of dating violence and abuse, the warning signs of dating violence and abusive behavior, the characteristics of healthy relationships, measures to prevent and stop dating violence and abuse, and community resources available to victims of dating violence and abuse.”
- Please see the following schedule below. Students should **report to their classes first** and an announcement will be made to release the following groups to the auditorium:
  - **1<sup>st</sup> Period:** Sophomores, Last names A-K
  - **2<sup>nd</sup> Period:** Seniors, Last names A-K
  - **3<sup>rd</sup> Period:** Juniors, Last names A-K
  - **4<sup>th</sup> Period:** NO Assembly
  - **5<sup>th</sup> Period:** Juniors, Last names L-Z
  - **6<sup>th</sup> Period:** Seniors, Last names L-Z
  - **7<sup>th</sup> Period:** Sophomores, Last names L-Z
- Freshmen students receive Healthy Relationship/Dating Violence curriculum through their HOPE classes, therefore they will not participate in the assemblies.

**WHAT:** “Be the Light” Assembly

**WHO:** Freshmen female students **ONLY**

- The Bartram Trail Dance Team is hosting a “Be the Light” assembly. The goal of the assembly is to promote positivity among our female students and encourage them to support one another.
