2020-2021 BTHS Parking Permits

Please read all the information carefully before starting your transaction. Follow all procedures and turn in this completed form and your payment on the designated dates.

ELIGIBILITY: Must be a Junior. No sophomores, **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Must have a valid Florida operator's driver license issued before October 2020. If you only have your learners permit at the time of registration but will get your operator's license before October 2020 you are eligible.

COST: \$100.00

PRIORITY PARKING RECIPIENTS: The top 100 juniors (determined by weighted GPA on January 21st, 2020) will have the opportunity to purchase a parking spot first. The top 100 will be contacted via email, text message and a list will be posted on a white board in the main cafeteria. We will NOT do this online. It will be done the old fashion way...in person, only by check made out to BTHS. Top 100 Juniors should turn in this completed form with their \$100 check made out to BTHS during their lunch in the main cafeteria between Tuesday, February 11th – Wednesday, February 12th. (If you don't do this you WILL NOT get a parking pass) A friend may turn it in for you.

LUTTERY PARKING RECIPIENTS: The remaining parking spots will be decided via lottery. Students will have to register for the lottery online or in the cafeteria anytime between Monday, February 10th and Friday, February 14th. Look for Junior Parking Lottery link on the parking website or **CLICK HERE>>** to enter online. You can also see Mr. Peaver in the main cafeteria during your lunch to have your name put in the drawing. A computer will randomly draw names and you will be notified via email and text if you have been selected. The list will also be posted on a white board in the main cafeteria on March 3rd. The number of spots available will be determined by the total number of spots purchased by Seniors and the top 100 juniors. Juniors may want to consider who they could share a spot with just in case they are not one of the fortunate individuals to have their name selected in the lottery.

Students who were fortunate enough to have their name drawn should turn in this completed form and their \$100 check, made out to BTHS, during their lunch in the main cafeteria between Monday, March 9th and Wednesday, March 11th. (If you don't do this you WILL NOT get a parking pass) A friend may turn it in for you.

DISTRIBUTION: Your hanging parking tag will be handed out during Open Campus in August. Lists of names and parking spots will be posted all around campus so you can locate your newly assigned spot.
