# St. Johns River State Dual Enrollment Eligibility

What are the requirements to take?

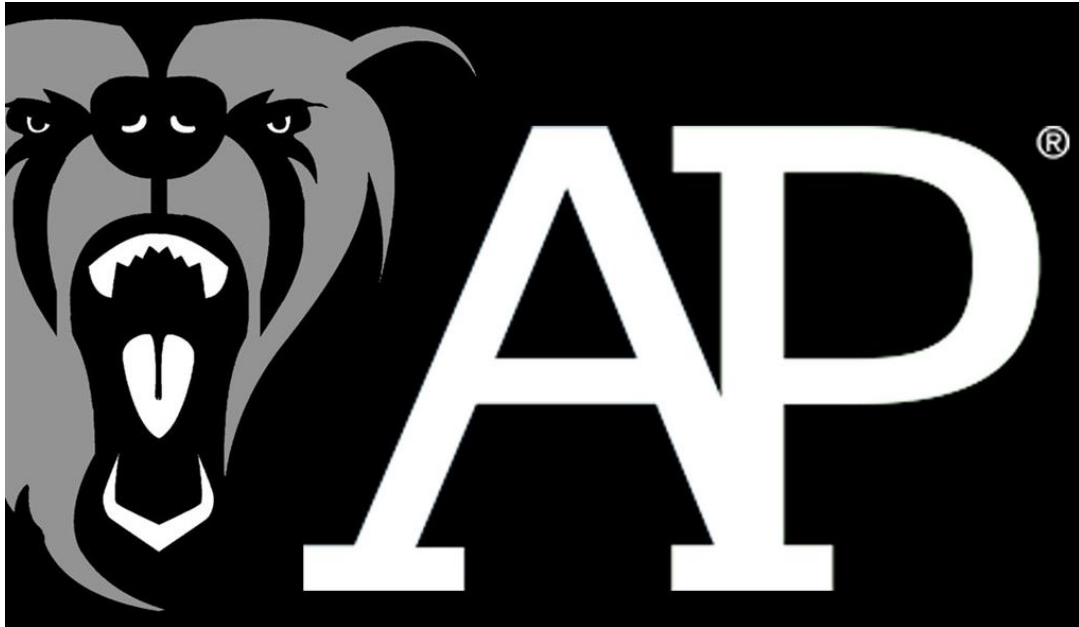
- Must have parent/guardian approval
- Must have (and maintain) a 3.0 GPA
- Must have one of the following score sets:
  - SAT = Reading 24, Writing 25, Math 25
  - ACT = Reading 19, English 17, Math 21
  - CPT = Reading 83, Sentence Skills 83, Math 85
  - PERT = Reading 106, English 103, Math 123

# Requirements for Both

Students must have the following to be successful in both options:

- Academic Ability (Level 4 or higher recommended on FSA)
- Good work ethic
- Attendance
- Balance
- Social & Emotional Maturity
- Transportation Considerations
- Understanding the WHY





# Transcripts

**How does the course affect/potentially affect transcript?**

## **AP COURSES**

### High School Transcript

- Grade counts toward High School transcript **ONLY**
- GPA: 5.0 out of 4.0 weighted

### College Transcript

- Credit is potentially earned by passing the AP exam
- College credit may be rewarded, **BUT** no college GPA is earned





# Transcripts

## DUAL ENROLLMENT

### High School Transcript

- Grade counts toward High School transcript
  - High School GPA 5.0 out 4.0
- High school equivalencies for graduation

### College Transcript

- Grade counts toward (or starts) College transcript
- Starts College GPA
  - 4.0 out of 4.0
