SENIOR CLASS DUE UPDATES

- REVISED SENIOR DUE is \$30 and can be paid via [SchoolPay](#).
- Senior Dues covers the cost of the diplomas, diploma covers, cords, programs, and various other items including a portion of the unexpected shipping of the caps and gowns home.
- **\$35 REFUNDS** are being processed for those who had paid the original dues amount of \$65. *Refunds will be issued electronically for those who paid dues 11/1/2019 and after. We will issue physical refund checks to all who paid before 11/1/2019. All checks should be mailed by 5/27/2020.*
- **SJCSD is covering the cost of the virtual graduation ceremony, this is not included in Senior Dues.*
