

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

ONLY 6 DAYS UNTIL THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL!

This email is to provide you specific information about **ARRIVAL/BEGINNING OF SCHOOL** procedures. You will receive an email regarding LUNCH/END OF SCHOOL procedures tomorrow evening (Wednesday, August 26th). We apologize for the length of this email, but it contains important information with some changes from last year.

ARRIVAL

The school building will be closed to students until 8:45am. ONLY the West Entrance (by the front administration office) will be opened at 8:45am. Additional doors/gates will be opened at 9:00am. ALL gates and entrances will be closed and secured by 9:30am. Anyone arriving after 9:30am will have to check in through the front administration office.

PARENT DROP-OFF

For the first couple of days, please expect there to be LONG delays in the morning. Please adhere to the following procedures for Parent Drop Off.

o AUDITORIUM PARKING LOT:

- Once you enter the parking lot, there is one way in and one way out. **Please use both lines when ENTERING.** [CLICK HERE>>](#) to view a more specific diagram of this process.
- Your student will be required to wait until you pull up. For safety reasons, we will not be letting students walk from vehicles from the main road or other areas.

o FRONT ADMINISTRATION CIRCLE:

- The other location you may drop off your student is the front by the administration building.
- No student can be dropped off in the bus loop, the 9th grade center, or any other parking lot.
- **All drivers must abide by the traffic laws, meaning no U-turns, no driving on the grass to get around the other vehicles, parking in designated areas only, not cutting across parking spots, abiding by posted speed limits, wearing seat belts, etc.**
- **A St. Johns Sherriff's Office Deputy will be on campus to make sure all rules are followed.**

PPE BEFORE SCHOOL PROCEDURES

- Students must wear face coverings on the school busses and **must wear them as they arrive on campus and proceed to first period.**
- All students will have their temperature taken in their first period class with a non-contact thermometer.
- Any student who has a temperature of **100.4 F or higher** will be given a pass and asked to report to the nurse's office with their backpack and any other belongings.
 - If the nurse confirms the temperature, a parent will be called for immediate pick up and the student will be isolated until the parent arrives.
- **We recommend and request that parents check their children's temperature before sending them to school each day and keep them home if they are running a fever.**

Students will report to their FIRST PERIOD on the first day of school. Students should check their HAC at 8:00 AM to ensure they know where they are heading for 1st period. We are not doing homerooms on the 1st day of school like we have in previous years.
