Ticket Info

- Tickets are \$10 per person, sold on Schoolpay.com from March 22nd-April 30th
- **TIME SLOTS ARE LIMITED TO 200 STUDENTS PER HOUR, IT WILL SELL OUT! PURCHASE ASAP!**
- Last day to buy tickets is April 30th! Tickets are final sale, no refunds.
- Pick up your MORP ticket during all lunches, May 3rd-7th. Bring your student ID and a printed copy or screen shot of your SchoolPay receipt to pick up your ticket.
- You will need your MORP ticket and your student ID to enter the event. There will not be a will call at the event.
