- **As needed medications require a medication authorization form sign by a physician. This includes non prescription over the counter medications.**
 - Students are allowed to self-carry non-prescription over the counter medications with a self-carry form signed by parent. Self-carry forms must be turned in to clinic.
 - Any prescription medication turned into the clinic must be in original container with valid prescription label.
 - Please check expiration dates on containers and labels. Expired medications will not be accepted by clinic.
 - Medications will not be accepted at drop off without proper forms signed by a physician. All
