

# **CORE RE-EVALUATION FORM**

All core courses must be recommended by the student's current teacher in that subject. If students feel they have been recommended for the wrong course or if they want to take a less rigorous course (Honors instead of AP or Standard instead of Honors), the student may fill out the core re-evaluation form **CLICK HERE**.

**If students meet the progression for the course**, the counselor will approve it and students should be able to see the course in HAC prior to the end of the school year.

**If students do not currently meet the progression,** student's request will not be reviewed until final grades have been posted and test scores return <u>over the summer.</u>

#### **ACADEMY COURSES**

If a student has been accepted into an Academy, students should see the course in HAC. If a student no longer wants to be in an Academy, complete **THIS FORM** to have the BTHS Academy course removed from the schedule. Academy courses are only added to a student's schedule though the district application and approval process. If a student applied and was accepted but does not see the academy course on the schedule request tab, contact Ms. Michelle Kisch.

#### VIRTUAL CLASSES

Planning to take a virtual class next year? Please complete <u>THIS FORM</u> to have the BTHS course removed from HAC and the virtual lab added. Students must also request the course on FLVS or SJVS, with an August 10<sup>th</sup> start date, by June 2, 2022. It is VERY IMPORTANT that students change their school of record in their FLVS account to Bartram Trail High School during the summer.

**Please Note:** Students may only take one virtual period on campus at BTHS due to seat availability. Students can opt to take more than one course virtually but will not have more than one virtual lab.
