CHECK OUT AFTER TESTING: Any student wishing to leave when testing is finished at 1:30 PM MUST complete the early check out form prior to 4 PM on February 28th. The school day will go until 3:50 PM for any student not completing the check out form.

Students completing the form will check out through the breezeway for that day only, near the front office.

BRIGHT FUTURES: Students will be evaluated for Bright Futures based on official test scores from the FDOE repository. To ensure Office of Student Financial Assistance obtains official test scores: Ensure demographics on your test registration and high school transcript match; and request your official test scores be sent to one of Florida's 12 state universities when registering for the ACT®/SAT®.
