**FREE ACT:** On **Tuesday, March 1<sup>st</sup>**, all 11<sup>th</sup> grade students will have the opportunity to take a College Reportable ACT, funded by the state, here on our campus.

Some important information about this ACT administration:

- \*It is funded by the state, there is no fee for students to participate
- \*It is college-reportable
- \*It can be used for Bright Futures
- \*It can be used as a concordant score for FSA ELA and Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirements

**WHAT TO BRING:** On test day, students will need to bring the following items: a valid photo ID (Driver's License, State Issued ID, or school/student ID), pencils and a calculator

**CHECK OUT AFTER TESTING:** Any student wishing to leave when testing is finished at 1:30 PM MUST complete the early check out form prior to 4 PM on February 28<sup>th</sup>. The school day will go until 3:50 PM for any student not completing the check out form.

Students completing the form will check out through the breezeway for that day only, near the front office.

**BRIGHT FUTURES:** Students will be evaluated for Bright Futures based on official test scores from the FDOE repository. To ensure Office of Student Financial Assistance obtains official test scores: Ensure demographics on your test registration and high school transcript match; and request your official test scores be sent to one of Florida's 12 state universities when registering for the ACT®/SAT®.
