### **CHOOSING ELECTIVE COURSES ONLINE**

Please use the instructions below to choose electives for the 2023-2024 school year. After students have chosen their electives, students will have the opportunity to meet with a BTHS Team Member to discuss their selections.

**Step 1:** Log into **STUDENT** HAC account using student username and password, **NOT** PARENT login. (DO NOT DO THIS UNTIL FEB. 17th at 4PM.) Step 2: Select "Classes" **Step 3:** Select the "Request" tab Step 4: Any course that is teacher recommended has a lock symbol next to it and cannot be changed. If students feel they have been recommended for the wrong course, students can fill out a core re-evaluation form- CLICK HERE. Step 5: Choose elective classes. Total number of classes listed should be SEVEN. Step 6: All courses that students can choose from are listed under the "Electives" tab. **Step 7:** To select a course, click edit on the far-right side of the ELECTIVE row and select the box next to the class or classes you wish to ADD. Then select SAVE. Step 8: Once there is a total of 7 courses, you are done! **Step 10:** If students still have questions regarding their schedule or classes to choose for next year, counselors and staff will be available to meet with students during scheduled middle school visits. 2023-2024 8th Grade Registration Schedule **DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 24th** 

## <mark>CORE RE-EVALUATION FORM (ENGLISH, MATH,</mark> <mark>SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES)</mark>

All core courses must be recommended by the student's current teacher in that subject. If students feel they have been recommended for the wrong course or if they want to take a less rigorous course (Honors instead of AP or Standard instead of Honors), the student may fill out the core re-evaluation form <u>CLICK HERE</u>.

**If students meet the progression for the course**, the counselor will approve it and students should be able to see the course in HAC prior to the end of the school year.

**If students do not currently meet the progression,** student's request will not be reviewed until final grades have been posted and test scores return <u>over the summer</u>.

Students must also request the course on FLVS or SJVS, with an August 10, 2023 start date, by May 25, 2023. It is VERY IMPORTANT that students change their school of record in their FLVS account to Bartram Trail High School during the summer.

**Please Note:** Students may only take one virtual period on campus at BTHS due to seat availability. Students can opt to take more than one course virtually but will not have more than one virtual lab.
