Medication drop off will be available on August 8th and 9th anytime between the hours of 8:30am and 2:30pm. After the 9th, you may drop off medication during normal school hours.

Please Note:

All emergency medications require medical management plans signed by a physician.

Daily medications require a medication authorization form signed by a physician.

As needed medications require a medication authorization form sign by a physician. This includes non prescription over the counter medications.

- Students are allowed to self-carry non-prescription over the counter medications with a self-carry form signed by parent. Self-carry forms must be turned in to the clinic.
- Any prescription medication turned into the clinic must be in original container with valid prescription label.
- Please check expiration dates on containers and labels. Expired medications will not be accepted by the clinic.
- Medications will not be accepted at drop off without proper forms signed by a physician. All forms are available for download at the bottom of the Bartram Trail High School home page. The link is provided below. If you have any questions please contact the clinic.
