WHAT'S GOING ON THIS MONTH IN THE COUNSELING OFFICE?

Senior Credit Checks:

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12th grade School Counselors will visit English classes and have individual meetings with Senior students. Counselors will review graduation requirements, credits earned, test scores, GPA, community service hours, Bright Futures, and discuss postsecondary plans. Counselors will also share information about credit recovery and possible ways to improve GPA. All students will receive a copy of their credit check. Students who do not have an English class should see their Counselor <u>AFTER</u> October 7th.

Ninth Grade Lessons:

9th grade School Counselors will welcome Freshmen students to BTHS and share information about how to make the next 4 years impactful. They will discuss the importance of grades, school involvement and making good choices.

Parent Night:

Parent Night will include pre-recorded virtual presentations. Please look for the School Counselor Power Point presentations which will highlight important information for all 9th-12th grade families.

<u>Counselor in the Courtyard:</u>

Each month on the 3rd Wednesday, Counselors are in the courtyard during lunch. Each month we focus on a specific topic. The purpose of this activity is to increase student engagement with School Counselors and provide students with valuable information and available resources.

The purpose of My Quest is to address questions or offer assistance in areas that often require Counselor involvement. My Quest is offered most months on the 4th Wednesday. Time TBD

Post-Secondary Visits:
