How should I prepare for my registration appointment?

Questions a school counselor might ask a student at their registration	How a student can prepare before their registration appointment:

What do you want to do after high school?	University, state college, technical school, military, work force?
What are your career interests? What do you plan to study in college?	Explore careers through elective classes, summer internships, career interest inventories, etc. Research education and training requirements. Choose high school courses that match your interest.
Where do you want to go to college?	Visit colleges. Speak to admissions representatives. Ask questions about what the institution is looking for in an applicant. Research required courses for your intended program of study.
What are the admissions criteria for your school of choice?	Know the average test scores, average GPA, high school courses, world language requirement, etc.
Are you planning on taking a course(s) online?	Students must declare intent to take courses virtually by the last day of school. Students may not drop a class to take the same course online once they are enrolled in the course.
Do you need Credit/Grade Recovery? (D or F only in an academic course)	Courses can be retaken via FLVS, SJVS or Edmentum. See your school counselor with any questions.
Are you an athlete? If so, do your classes meet NCAA requirements? Please note, NCAA does not recognize Edmentum courses.	Research the requirements for NCAA. Student athletes must register with the NCAA eligibility center.
Do you plan on applying for dual enrollment? Which class(es) would you take? Would you prefer am or pm modified periods?	Think about how dual enrollment would impact your BTHS schedule. See your school counselor with any questions.
Are you requesting to modify a class period(s)? (11th or 12th gr only) Would you prefer am or pm modified periods?	Are you meeting graduation requirements? Consider your commitments — academic rigor, extracurricular activities, work. Please note, this is a request and not guaranteed.
Do you have a job? (11 th or 12 th gr only)	Consider CO-OP as a course option.
