

FAST Progress Monitoring for Grades 9-10



The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is given three times a year to track student progress in English Language Arts (ELA) based on the B.E.S.T. Standards. The first test (PM1) serves as a baseline and does not affect grades or promotion. After testing, parents/students can view scores in the <u>Family Portal</u>.

FAST & EOC Retakes (FALL) - Graduation Requirement Reminder

Students who have not yet met state testing requirements for graduation may need to retake the FAST ELA assessment or specific End-of-Course (EOC) exams (such as Algebra 1). These retakes are essential for meeting Florida's graduation standards.

Non -College Reportables, also known as NCRs, are SAT or ACT exam scores that are NOT reported to colleges or scholarship agencies. NCR scores are used for state assessment purposes only.

Things to know...

- Students must "join" their AP class(es) online:
 AP Teachers will provide join codes.
- Regular test dates & late test dates (below):
- Students who drop one or more AP courses after tests have been ordered WILL incur a fee of \$40.
- Students who need to late test or are absent on the day of testing are also subject to fees of \$40 or MORE. Fees are determined by College Board.
- <u>Deadline to apply for AP accommodations is</u> <u>January 16, 2026, 11:59 p.m.</u>

**Exam schedule is determined by College Board. Be mindful of dates and plan accordingly. Note that some late testing is on Graduation Day & AFTER graduation. This schedule cannot be altered.
