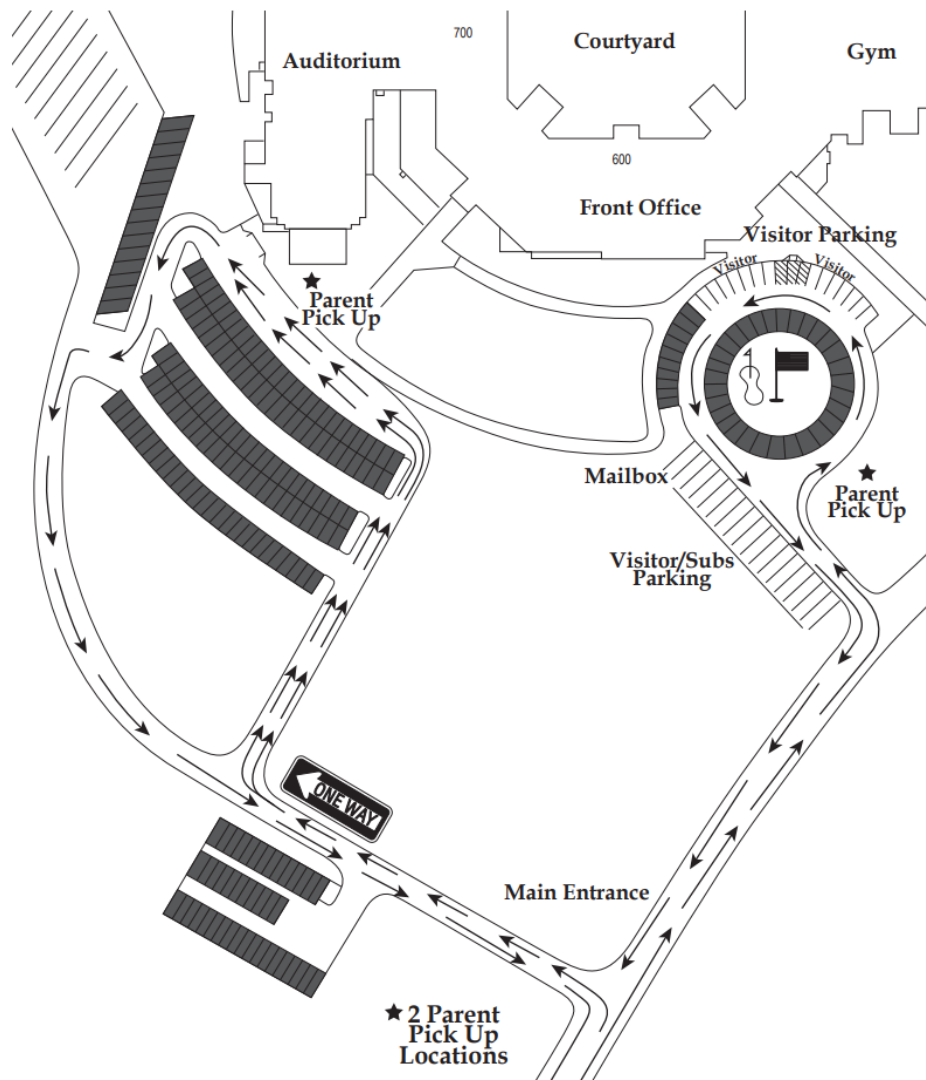
- Online account to add money for student's lunch. You can access this from the web page and register if you do not already have an account.

Pick Up & Drop Off

- Gates open at 8:45am each morning
Only TWO gates/doors will be open each morning.
Bus Loop Entrance & West Entrance by the administration entrance
- Dismissal is @3:50pm, except Wednesdays @2:50pm
- 2 parent drop-off/pick-up areas: Auditorium and Flag Pole at Front Office (map on next slide)

Bus Riders

- Bus Loop is located by the 9th Grade Building
- Signs will be placed to indicate no entrance for parent pick up so you will not drive in the bus loop
- The buses do not park in the same spot everyday so please remind your student to check each bus for their assignment. There is a 10-minute window of time to get from their last class to buses and locate the correct bus.
- There is a process for riding a different bus- Cannot just bring in a note. Permission must be obtained through the Transportation Department.
- To find your child's assigned bus, please check your BusPlanner account as we get closer to the first day of school which is August 10th.

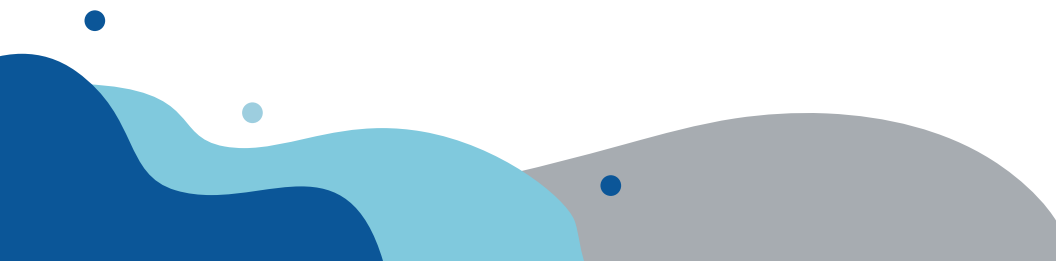

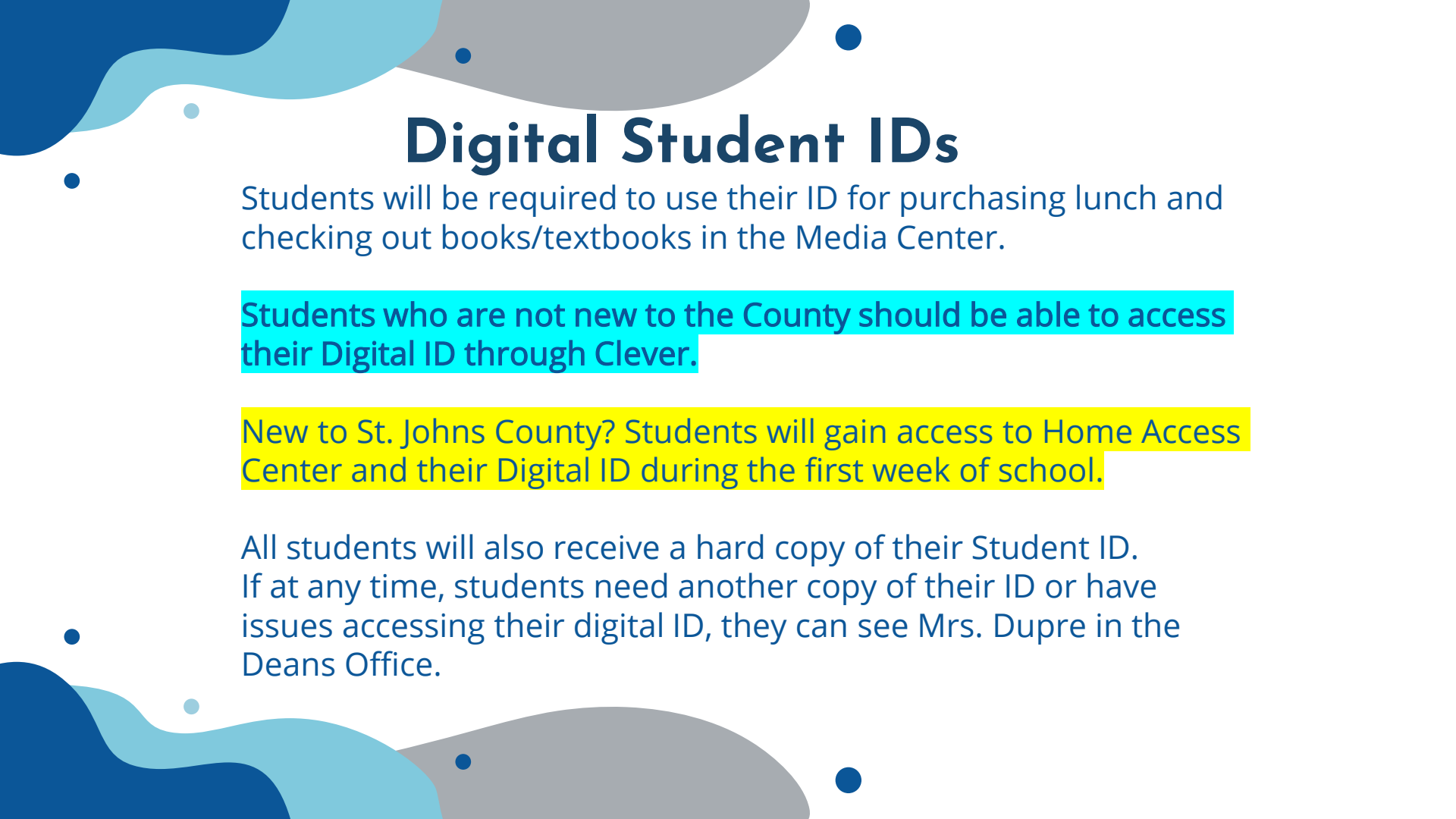




Student Lockers

Important Discipline Policy Updates

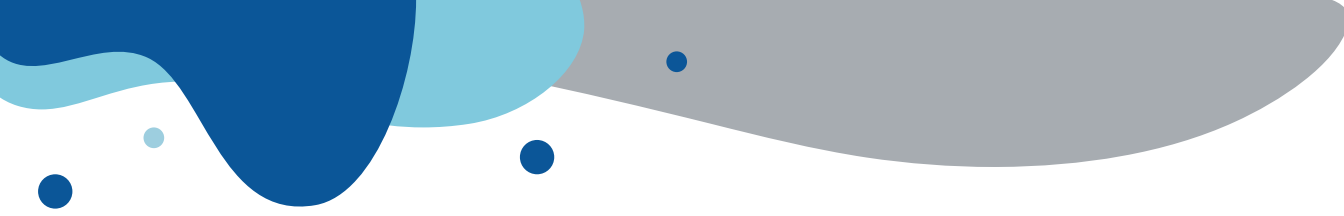
E-Bikes:

Students may ride Class 2 E-Bikes and Electric Scooters to school. Class 2 E-Bikes do not exceed an assisted speed of 20 MPH.

Once students enter the main gate all E-Bikes and regular bicycles must be walked to the bike rack. **No bikes or E-bikes can be ridden on campus.**

Electric Motorcycles are not allowed on campus at all. The only exception would be if the Motorcycle is registered with the DMV and the student has purchased a parking pass. In this case, the rider and the vehicle would be treated as any motor vehicle on campus. Which means riding on the street, not the sidewalk or grass. The rider is expected to follow all traffic laws.



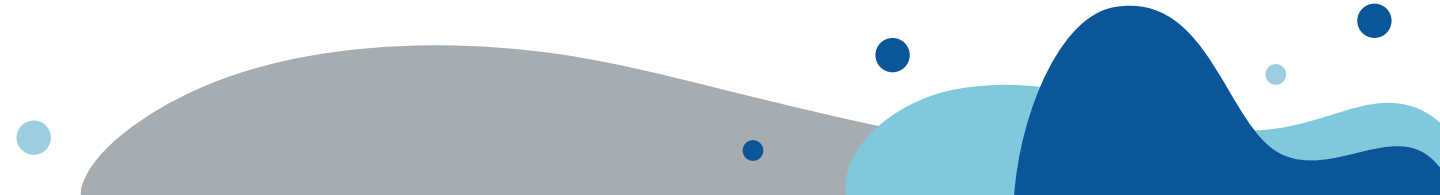


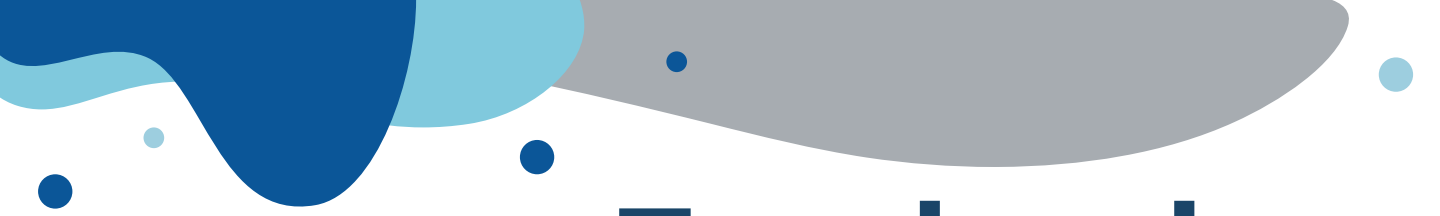
Important Discipline Policy Updates (continued)

Cell Phones and Smart Devices:

Students will only be allowed to use their cell phones in school during lunch, class changes, or when expressly permitted by a classroom teacher for instructional purposes. They will not be allowed to use their cell phones when out on hall passes during class. This applies to all smart devices that function similarly.

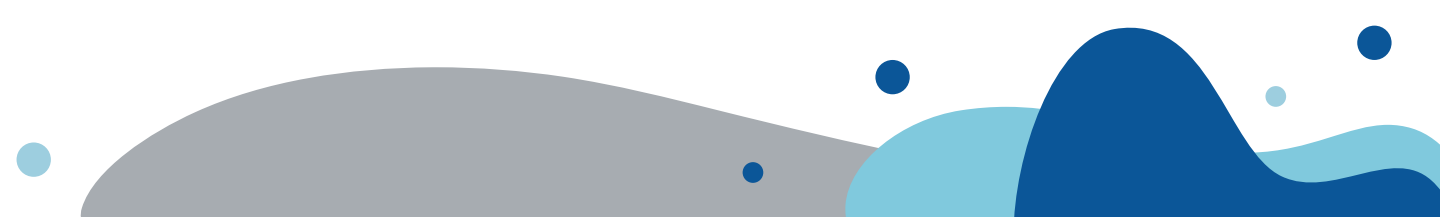
Meta Glasses are not allowed on campus.





Textbooks

During the first week of school, teachers will be distributing textbooks to their students. Many classes use online texts and resources that are accessed through the student's Clever Sign on. Teachers will review this information with students the first week of school and inform parents through Schoology.





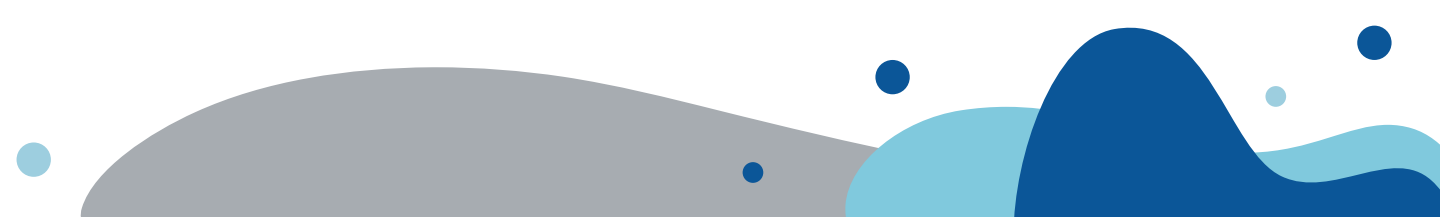
First Day Flow

- Campus opens at 8:45am
 - 1st Period begins at 9:20, students should be in class by this time.
 - If students cannot see their schedule in HAC, front office staff will be available to assist.
 - Staff and Leadership students will be located throughout the campus, happy to assist and direct students.
 - For lunch, students will report to their 4th period class and receive direction.
 - Lunches are served in the main cafeteria, however students may eat in either cafeteria or the courtyard.
 - At the end of the day, bus riders will proceed to the bus loop (behind the 9th Grade Building). Many staff members will be present to assist.
 - Parents can pick up using the locations outlined earlier. Make sure your kiddo communicates with you which pickup location they are at.
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First Week Flow

Students will:

- Receive textbooks and access to online resources
 - Attend an informational safety meeting
 - Attend class assemblies where we discuss procedures and expectations
 - Have yearbook pictures taken (August 14th)
